President Message

Greetings and a happy start to the summer! While challenges continue, we try to count our blessings and celebrate the positive. On that note, I will start by celebrating the return to the AAPA inperson conference this year! It was a huge success in both the House of Delegates, main events, and education. APAOG was able to recommend stronger language to our opposition to reproductive restrictions, and the amendment was adopted. We also supported or amended several policies such as branding for the "asociado medico" title, increased CME credit for precepting



PA students, breastfeeding support, button battery safety education, and others. The AAPA also released its new branding campaign, "#PAsGoBeyond" which includes a multifaceted approach to educate the public on our profession and capture our uniqueness in going beyond the standard medical and surgical treatment to incorporate the whole patient, their culture, and values. Be sure to check it out and share!

We continue to collaborate with women's health organizations and participate in subcommittees aimed at standardizing and improving obstetric practice. We have also started partnering with the Alliance for Innovation in Maternal Health (AIM) to increase educational resources for PAs. This month, I will again represent APAOG and the AAPA at the Annual Maternal Immunization Summit, hosted by ACOG, and will be sure to keep you posted. We have also added a new webpage on education resources for Immunization in Pregnancy.

A few APAOG-specific updates include the acceptance of a new NCCPA CAQ in Obstetrics and Gynecology, set to launch in Spring 2024. Work groups are taking form to come together and build the best product for all participants. We also collaborated with Thomas Jefferson University's Certified Midwifery Online Program to create a curriculum for PAs interested in entering midwifery. We will likely host additional informational sessions in the fall. Our summer issue from the Artemis journal is set to release in July, so please submit your articles soon. Be sure to check out the APAOG podcast with a great mix of educational topics and interviews. And this month's webinar is on diversity, equity, and inclusion in women's health, a timely topic with the rising rates of maternal morbidity and mortality. Lastly, our elections are open for voting, please vote for your next board members and committee chairs. Also, consider volunteering for committees to help improve the landscape for OBGYN PAs!
