


Annual Meeting

CONFERENCE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this program, providers/clinicians will be able to:

- Prescribe therapy for the most common gynecologic symptom of childhood
- Apply new principles of pain management, fluid management, and pre-, intraand post-op recovery principles
- Structure an office visit with an adolescent so that confidentiality is assured, yet cooperation between parent, adolescent, and clinician is facilitated
- Identify new treatment options, classifications and screening data in ovarian cancer management based on genetic alterations
- Determine clinical risk factors for the morbidly adherent placenta and the role
 of antenatal imaging for risk assessment
- Identify and implement current recommendations for following a MC twin pregnancy
- Describe the use of standardized screening for substance use in pregnancy
- · Identify patients who fit criteria for late preterm steroids
- Compare definitions for lichen simplex chronicus, its clinical presentations, differential diagnoses and current treatment options
- Describe the 2017 NC legislative debates concerning scope of practice, Medicaid and other issues of concern to OB/Gyn physicians and their patients
- Define vulvodynia, the algorithm for diagnosis and current treatment options available
