

Clinical Update - Female Anatomy and Sperm Success

Researchers at Cornell are placing more emphasis on the role that sperm motility has in successful fertilization. In the past more emphasis has been placed on sperm count followed by morphology, but there is new evidence that the make-up of the female reproductive tract promote success for the strongest swimmers, highlighting sperm motility as a key characteristic. The article written in *HealthDay News* states "A woman's reproductive system presents a veritable obstacle course that stress-tests sperm, making sure that only the strongest swimmers have a chance of reaching a woman's egg". This new information could lead to a adjustments and new technologies in reproductive healthcare that may aid in both natural and assisted reproduction.
